## 2019 LWML CONVENTION REGISTRATION IS NOW OPEN



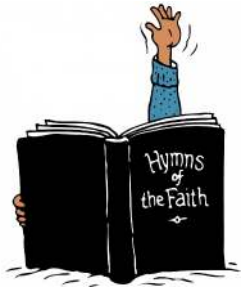

Please continue to save Noble's grocery receipts. Check the library for deposit of receipts, and see other things that can be saved.



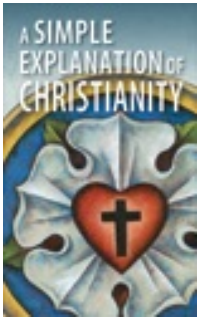
The Rev. John Fehrmann, president of the **Confessional Lutheran Education Foundation**

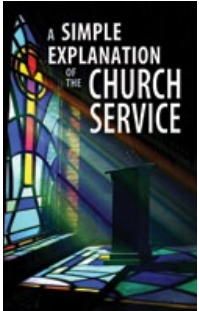


**Concordia Theological Seminary** has accepted my application for the
